- 5. Discuss Idaho Water Revision Legislation -

Starweather has 2 water rights one for Domestic & Irrigation, so we are not directly impacted by the new legislation clarifying that irrigation of lawn, gardens, etc. can not be done using a domestic water right.

Where we may be impacted is if we are required to prove we are staying within our irrigation limits. If that occurs, we may need to put water meters on the household irrigation lines. Starweather's domestic use is approximately 534 gallons per home/day. This is well above the national average of 300/gallons a day.

To better understand the Starweather's overall consumption levels, the Board decided to begin tracking the well-level meter at the total community level (which is both domestic & irrigation) to create a baseline of water usage.

6. Fall Community Social – Jimmy is going to follow up with Ellise to see if we could use her bridge. If yes, we will determine a date in October and communicate it out to Starweather Homeowners.

7. Updates:

- a. Generator Prep work is almost complete; we are still waiting for the generator. Once it is in we should be able to install it right away.
- b. Chip/Seal Still looking at Mid to End of September
- c. Ott Excavation Work Complete, they dug the line deeper, covered it with pipe insulation and then blue foam board.
